

The Class of '67 Scholarship

Requirements

- I. A good, solid student with a B or C average.
- II. A plan for the future that includes the completion of vocational or technical training, or attaining an associates or a bachelor's degree.
- III. A letter to us, describing career goals and why you wish to attend the institution you have chosen. (We are not looking for composition of great eloquence, but a clear statement of goals.)
- IV. Include a resume which lists all activities and/or organizations in which you have participated while in high school. In addition, list all job experience and/or volunteer activities.
- V. A completed **Class of '67 Scholarship** application.
- VI. Two letters of reference are required. One letter must come from an A. C. Jones High School teacher and the second from a member of the community with personal knowledge of the applicant.
- VII. Proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institution must be submitted to the Barnhart Scholarship Office before the scholarship check of \$500 is delivered. The second check of \$500 will be issued when the student furnished proof of a 2.5 average for the first semester and proof of enrollment for the spring.
- VIII. The due date is Wednesday, April 16, 2010
